This Compliance Statement is being provided to demonstrate compliance of molded polystyrene foam produced by Atlas Molded Products with Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6(h).

TSCA Section 6(h) prohibits the use of the following persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT) Chemicals:

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

Atlas' molded polystyrene foam products do not contain any of the above-mentioned hazardous substances and therefore comply with the environmental standards set forth by TSCA Section 6(h).
